Ms. Casey started her career with the federal government in October 1973 with the United States Secret Service (USSS) Personnel Division. From that time until 1986, she worked in the Staffing and Recruitment Branch and Employee Relations. During this period, she served as the USSS Federal Woman's Program Manager and became involved with the then titled Interagency Committee on Women in Federal Law Enforcement. She served as Conference Co-Chair for two annual training conferences, as well as the Department of Treasury Chair for the Committee.

Over the years, Ms. Casey served in various positions and assignments at USSS and in May 2001 she was selected and reassigned to the position of Staff Assistant to the Assistant Director, Office of Human Resources and Training. In March 2002, Ms. Casey transferred to the newly formed Transportation Security Administration as Program Analyst (Human Resources Liaison), Office of Strategic Management and Analysis. She retired from federal service in February 2006, but in April returned to work as a federal contractor working for the Department of Homeland Security, Office of Chief Security Officer, as a Security Analyst.

Ms. Casey holds a B.A. in Business Administration (Management) from Mount Vernon College (now part of George Washington University) in Washington, DC. She currently serves as co-editor of the quarterly WIFLE E-news.
