DOJ SECURITY GUIDELINES:

Non-DOJ government employees will need to bring their agency photo ID and another photo ID (i.e. drivers' license). Individuals who are not government employees need a form of picture identification, i.e., drivers' license.

Non-DOJ employees will be processed through metal detectors and x-ray scan of their hand carried items. Persons to be processed are encouraged to bring only essential items to avoid delays.

DOJ component Law Enforcement employees (Access Category 1) will be allowed to carry weapons in the building in performance of their regular duties. Non DOJ component US Government Law Enforcement personnel will be required to secure weapons in provided lock boxes unless they are performing an active detail in the building.
