Undercover for the Female Officer - (IS-020)

Pre-requisite None: Training duration: 24 Hours

This training program is offered to newly assigned or experienced Investigators, Agents and Officers (non-sworn) Personnel who work or will work undercover. NOTE: ATTENDING STUDENTS HAVE FREQUENTLY BROUGHT "AGENCY OWNED" SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT TO THIS TRAINING PROGRAM FOR TRAINING AND FAMILIARIZATION, WHEN AVAILABLE.

Course Description: Undercover operations play a paramount role in the effort to combat illegal criminal activity. In this highly specialized field, the female officer has played a significant part. She has proved extremely effective, especially in the areas of vice and narcotics enforcement. Most traditional undercover training has been directed towards officers in general with little or no regard to officer gender. The unique problems and situations that female officers sometimes face are often not addressed. This three (3) day comprehensive program is designed to give the female officer a good working knowledge of undercover operations with a distinct emphasis on the female perspective. Emphasis is put on officer safety and working within established legal and ethical parameters.

Course Objectives: Attendees will study and learn good working knowledge of undercover operations with a distinct emphasis on the female perspective. Attendees will study and learn video surveillance in numerous operational environments. Subject of study includes:

- ◆ Legal Issues/Ethics Issues
- ◆ Definitions and Terminology
- ◆ Levels of Undercover
- ◆ Logistics
- ◆ Female U/C Role
- ◆ Enforcement Strategies
- ◆ Undercover Violence
- ◆ Morale/Officer Attitude
- ◆ Courtroom Survival

Classes generally range in size from 6 to 16 students. Depending on the course subject matter, certain classes may contain a greater or lesser number of students. *A training manual, resource materials and handouts are all a part of this training program.*
A certificate will be awarded to each attendee successfully completing this course.
