Supervisory Special Agent Dorian Van Horn serves as the Supervisory Special Agent for Violent Crimes, Death, and the Threat Management Unit.

Since joining the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) in 1987, SSA Van Horn has been assigned to seven different duty stations located around the United States and around the world. Her career with NCIS has been focused on the investigation of crimes against women and children.

Her passion for this work has helped galvanize the growth of the Threat Management Unit so that NCIS now has agents and analysts posted in every major field office. SA Van Horn recently conducted the specialized training for more than a dozen new TMU agents who are assigned to the field offices.

SSA Van Horn supervises and provides consultation on all TMU investigations affecting the United States Navy and Marine Corps. These investigations include murder for hire, stalking, workplace violence, domestic violence, school violence, serial sexual assaults, arson, sabotage and insider threat. SSA Van Horn has also initiated TMU training programs for law enforcement agencies in domestic and international forums outside of NCIS. Her outreach and consultation to other law enforcement agencies reaches around the globe. Other law enforcement agencies are consulting with NCIS Threat Management Unit. More law enforcement agencies are looking to create their own departments or improve their own efficiencies and effectiveness in combating threats before they escalate into homicide.

Her professional affiliations include the Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP) and the National Center for Victims of Crime (NCVC).
