

Lisa Lambeth, Probation Officer Administrator/ Instructor:

Lisa began her federal career as a US Probation officer in the Northern District of Texas, Dallas, Texas, where she worked for 15 years. Most of those years she spent as an Intensive Supervision Specialist, supervising post conviction offenders whom were identified as high risk to re-offend. This often included high level drug dealers, career white collar offenders, gang members, violent offenders and organized crime members. It was in this position that she developed the surveillance team and worked on numerous task force operations including the Domestic Terrorism Task Force, the Asian Gang Task Force and The Russian Organized Crime Task Force. She also served as an assistant firearms instructor for 15 years. Beginning in January 2006, Lisa has worked as an instructor at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) in Charleston, SC, specializing in firearms training. She conducted advanced firearms training with several federal law enforcement agencies including US Courts, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), US Marshal's WITSEC Program, the US Army's Combat Camera Program and the Coast Guard. In 2008, she was transferred to the US Courts National Training Academy as a full time instructor. Lisa primarily leads firearms' instruction, however, also develops curricula , teaches defensive tactics and testifying skills.

In April 2008, Lisa and an incredible team of instructors developed and presented a Female Firearms Training Program for the US Probation and Pretrial Services Offices of the Northern District of California. This training was so successful that a second training was conducted for the US Probation and Pretrial Service Office in the District of Arizona. It was out of this program that the Female Officer Safety Training (FOST) program was developed. This program is offered two times a year , one on the West Coast named in honor of US Probation Officer JaDee Voss and one on the East Coast. The FOST program is offered to female US Probation and Pretrial Services Officers nation wide. We are thankful that the US Probation and Pretrial Services system recognized the need for female specific training.
